Event Report for Mission LiFE at Embassy of India, Moscow form 10-14 July

1. Energy Saved: SAVE ENERGY CAMPAIGN

- (a) Use of LED bulbs / tube-lights was encouraged.
- (b) Staff was encouraged to ensure that all the electric appliances are switched off when not in use.
- (c) Use of public transport or carpooling with friends and colleagues was encouraged.
- (d) It was encouraged to switch off vehicle engines at traffic lights.

2. Water Saved:

- (a) Flushes, taps and water pipes of the Embassy were checked for any leakage.
- (b) Staff was encouraged to turn off running taps when not in active use.

3. Single Use Plastic Reduced:

(a) Embassy Premises was declared a Plastic Free Zone – use of non-plastic eco-friendly cutlery was encouraged during gatherings and events.

4. Waste Reduced (Swachhata Actions):

(a) Staff was encouraged to set printer default to double-side printing and not to discard waste in public spaces. Bins were installed at various locations in the Embassy.

5. Healthy Lifestyles adopted:

(a) Plantation of trees to reduce the impact of pollution - Trees were planted by Ambassador in JNCC premises on 14 July 2023.

6. Mission LiFE Brochure was uploaded on Embassy website and Mission LiFE posters were uploaded daily on social media handles (viz. Twitter, Facebook etc.) from 10-14 July 2023.

7. Posters were installed for promotion of Mission LiFE activities in 3 Embassy buildings.

8. Mission LiFE videos were played on loop in visitor hall of Consular Wing to bring awareness.
