Report on an event on 09.05.2023 organized by National River Conservation Directorate, Department of WR, RD & GR, Ministry of Jal Shakti in respect of World Environment Day Celebration on 05.06.2023 at Divan Chand Arya, Sr. Sec. School at Lodhi Road, Aliganj, New Delhi – 110003.



1. The event aimed to raise awareness about the importance of preserving the environment and encourage students to take action towards a sustainable future. The event included a Drawing/ Painting competition and essay competition topic Ecosystem Restoration/ Clean & Green Mother Earth (for Class IX to X), Save the Water/ River Conservation (for Class VI to VIII), Solution to Plastic Pollution/ River Conservation.
